

# WCSS 18

## EVENT REGULATIONS

Welcome to WCSS 18. In order to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants, we ask you read the following regulations. Please be sure to sign the acknowledgement statement at registration that you have received the registration packet, which contains a copy of your registration information, a wristband, which identifies you as a paid participant, a map of the event locations, a schedule of events, and this copy of the regulations governing the event, as well as campground regulations if you are camping on the premises.

- Entry fee is \$15 per car for pre-registered participants; and \$15 per car if registering at the gate upon arrival, and includes all passengers in the vehicle. Walk-In (non-Subaru) attendees will pay \$5 per person.
- Entry into the event also covers your vehicle in the "Show & Shine". ALL Subaru vehicles will be parked in the show area, which will be divided into areas for each of the designated classes. This will provide for photo opportunities, showing the entire field of marque attendees.
- Attendees arriving in vehicles other than Subarus will be parked in a separate area outside of the "Show & Shine" field.
- For the "Show & Shine", please post your car # sticker on the upper right corner of your windshield, and place the card containing vehicle specifics below it on the dash, or taped to the interior of the windshield.
- All vendors on site must be pre-approved by the WCSS 18 Committee. There will be no commercial displays or banners allowed which have not been pre-arranged.
- Speed limit within the show area is 5 MPH
- FIREWORKS of any kind, whether legal or illegal, are forbidden on the premises. Anyone discharging ANY TYPE OF FIREWORKS will be asked to leave immediately.
- Alcoholic beverages are not to be consumed by anyone under 21 years of age. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the show area. Washington State Law prohibits anyone from bringing large quantities of any alcoholic beverages onto the site and distributing them. A hefty fine can be levied for violation of this law. Anyone behaving in an unruly manner which disturbs event participants or constitutes a safety concern will be asked to leave. Intoxicated persons will be evicted.
- Camping area is for registered and paid participants of WCSS 18 only. Wristbands required.

# WCSS 18 - CAMPING REGULATIONS

- The camping fee is \$25 for 1 night, or \$35 for both Fri & Sat. Camping is charged by the tent. The fee for small RVs is the same. You must pay the camping fee at registration, and will be given a tag to place on your tent or RV to show that you have paid. Large RV's need to camp in the fairgrounds campground.
- Camping is allowed in designated camping areas only. You must have a paid tag displayed on all RVs and tents.
- Boundaries between campsites in the camping areas are not well delineated. Please be considerate of other campers and keep your site reasonably compact to allow as many campers as possible. Please leave ample room for access roads between campsite rows.
- You may have your vehicle in the camping area at or near your campsite PENDING that we have enough room. You may be asked to condense or relocate a vehicle to fit more camp spots.
- **Quiet Hours** are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Please refrain from unnecessarily noisy activities or loud music and extinguish bright lights during those hours. There will be **no group gatherings** in the quiet area after 10:00 PM. If you wish to stay up and converse (even quietly), please do so outside of the designated quiet zone. Anyone who must be asked more than once to quiet down will be asked to leave.
- **Speed limit** in the campground is 5 MPH
- **FIREWORKS** of ANY KIND, whether legal or illegal, are not allowed in the campground. Anyone discharging ANY TYPE of fireworks will be asked to leave immediately.
- **No ATVs, Pit Bikes**, or other motorized people movers in the campground.
- **Alcoholic beverages:** Washington State Law prohibits bringing large quantities of any alcoholic beverages for general distribution. Kegs and cases of beverages are strictly prohibited, and will be confiscated and destroyed. Small amounts for PERSONAL USE ONLY may be brought to the camp site, and may not be consumed by anyone under 21 years of age. All alcoholic beverages must remain in the campground area at all times. **Entrants may not carry any alcohol to other areas.** Unruly behavior which disturbs other campers or constitutes a safety concern will not be tolerated, and the individual will be asked to leave immediately. Intoxicated people will be evicted. We wish to keep this event "Family Friendly", and WCSS committee members should not need to stay up and police the campground.
- **FIRES** are not allowed in individual campsites. Gas BBQ's are allowed. Do NOT leave any cooking fires or grills unattended, and be sure they are completely extinguished when no longer in use.
- **Garbage** is to be put into plastic bags and tied, then placed in the garbage cans provided on the grounds.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times. You are required to clean up after your pet. No pets will be allowed in the show/vendor building or grandstands. Keep in mind that the camping field can be extremely hot at this time of year.
